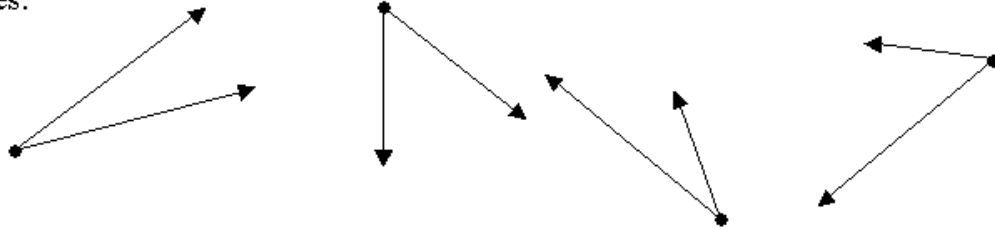

An angle is two rays with a common endpoint. There are four different types of angles that we use in elementary school.

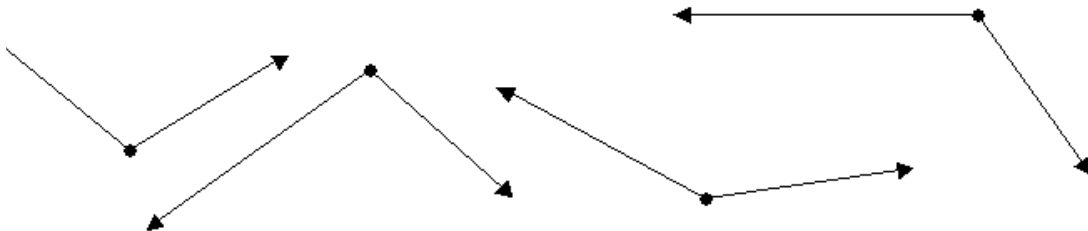
An acute angle measures less than 90 degrees. The following are acute angles:



A right angle measures exactly 90 degrees. The following are right angles:



An obtuse angle is an angle that measures more than 90 degrees but less than 180 degrees. The following are examples of obtuse angles:



A straight angle measures exactly 180 degrees. The following are examples of straight angles:
