Lesson: Ordering Numbers (Use Handout #6)

Lesson Plan

Grade Level: 3

Sunshine State Standard: MA.A.1.2.1, MA.A.1.2.2

Objective:

1. Students will be able to order numbers from least to greatest and greatest to smallest.
2. Students will find commonalities among a group of numbers such as 6 being found in thousands place in each of four numbers.
3. Students will be able to compare numbers using $<$, $=$, and $>$.
4. Students will be able to write word descriptions of numbers in standard form.
5. Students will be able to identify the correct position of a number on a number line.

Activity:

Using Handout #6

1. Students examine several numbers and find the digit that has the same place value in several different numbers.
2. Students compare the value of a number on its left to the value of the number on its right.
3. Students write word descriptions of numbers into standard form.
4. Students place numbers in the appropriate place on a number line.
